The following unsolicited testimonial letters and comments, from past and prospective clients, and others, are just a sampling of hundreds, from my first ten years, as the number one night sky muralist on this planet. The common theme, as you can easily see, is that literally everyone that has ever seen, or experienced, my one of a kind dynamic art form, StarMurals...is literally blown away by the magical and powerful effects. *Nothing else on this planet compares*.

The following are presented in random form, covering the entire ten years...most with a few comments, to provide context. They are divided into several categories, beginning with StarMurals large and small scale mural projects...painted live, by hand, one star at a time, in pitch black darkness, on ceilings and walls, in residential and commercial environments, far and wide.

I'll start with one of my favorite commercial projects, all 4 suites of a new state of the art sleep lab, that is part of a large neurology and MRI practice, in Ocala, FL, all with my signature Day & Night Sky ceilings...plus additional StarMurals ceilings in Dr. Kim's private office, a training conference room, and the executive conference room...7 StarMurals in all...three added on after my arrival.

Public response to your sky work in our sleep lab has been overwhelming. I do like the night sky painting. It's so cool. You are welcome to use our sleep lab as your show site if you so desire. Thank you for everything. - Dr. Kim

Dr. Kim's Practice Manager, Katrina, wrote: Just wanted to share with you that the grand opening was a success. The individuals that came were astounded at the night vision that you did on the ceilings. They were just awestruck. Thank you again for doing such a fantastic rendering. I had a CEO here that had flown in from Vegas who is looking to set up a diagnostic center which was focused on MRI but after I showed him the sleep lab and gave him the sleep experience he thought it was so wonderful that they are going to consider adding sleep to their facility. Thank you again it was an absolute pleasure meeting you and having the opportunity to enjoy your talent.

On a great pre-holiday trip to Dallas one year, I created a most unique StarMural, on the most unique ceiling ever...level on the sides then sharply peaking, from about 9 feet to a center point above 14 feet. As always with my work, real depth combined with my illusionary depth, is powerful and dynamic. The client commissioned the work as a holiday gift for his wife.

Now that we've gotten thru the holiday season and a few other work related items - I wanted to send a special thank you for our StarMural. Cheryl loves it more every day. I did buy it for her, but her reactions are more emphatic now than when she first saw it. Cheryl had a birthday party for me during the Christmas holiday and that was the first showing of the art. The ooo's and ahh's were just a short accolade of comments. Of course you've heard them all before.

This one was great, and the winner of most StarMurals projects in one home...12. I traveled to Canada a couple of years back to paint one large...over 900 square feet...StarMural, on a huge peak style ceiling...very severe pitch...in the fourth floor attic of a new 15,000 square foot palace in the Beverly Hills of Mississauga, Ontario, Canada, Lorne Park. The family was so happy with the first StarMural that they just kept on adding on spaces. Following are their comments on their bedroom.

We are star gazing at the moment, and we are in awe of this "starfabulous" sight - that's another word for your vocabulary. You have skyrocketed our bedroom into another planet and we are lost for words...Thank you for an excellent work of art and may your stars see many skies in the near future.
